**LeadX** is a unique, 6-session long leadership development program designed by [DCI Fellows](#) specifically for Stanford graduate students. Participants commit to monthly meetings with Fellows from the Stanford DCI program who are proven leaders and are open to sharing an intergenerational perspective. 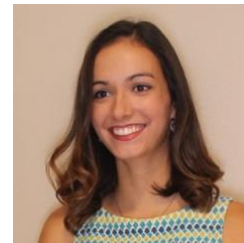
